Vacation

Only full- time students are eligible for Vacation. After twelve(12) months, parents receive one (1 week of vacation. Vacation periods are from your enrollment date. It does not roll over. Your child cannot attend Time of Wonder during that week. We require a two weeks notice. School-Age is part-time, they are not eligible.

Tuition

A second child discount is \$10.00 of the lowest tuition amount of the two children.

A security deposit, equal to one-week tuition, is due upon registration. If you give us a 2 weeks notice of intent to withdraw, your security deposit will cover the last week of tuition, only if the child has been enrolled for 90 consecutive days. Any amount left over is non-refundable.

Tuition is due every Monday. No later than 5:30pm. Personal checks are not accepted. Payment must be made by cash, money order or ACH. There is a \$40.00 charge for each returned payment.

Parents agree to pay full tuition amount for any child absences, inclusive illness, and when the center must close for causes beyond its control, bad weather included.

Refunds are not given for absences, holiday break schedule on the school calendar, bad weather included.

Hours of Operation

Monday- Friday:7:00am-6:00pm Nursery(Infants): 7:00am-5:30pm

Cut off time:9:30am(All children should be here by this time)

Late pick up: a late fee of(\$3.00)per minute will be charged for each child picked up after 6:00pm(Infants 5:30pm).

Please note if an observed holiday falls on a Saturday, we will be closed on a Friday. If an observed holiday falls on Sunday, we will be closed on that following Monday.

General Health

If a child is sent home with one of the following illnesses, he/she cannot return unless he/she is symptom free for at least 24 hours. For infectious diseases, we will need a doctor's notice that allows the child to return to school.

- Chicken Pox
- Conjunctivites (pink eye)
- Measles
- Mumps
- Fever of 100 degree or higher
- Excessive diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Wheezing or respiratory illness
- Undiagnosed rash
- Sore throat
- Any contagious

Any children who become ill at school will be isolated. The parents will be contacted, and the child must be picked up within one hour to avoid spreading of any infection to the other children or teachers. We strongly urge parents to act immediately when contacted for the safety and well being of everyone at Time of Wonder School.

Registration Information

Time of Wonder charges an annual registration fee every August. We also charge a supply fee every year. These fees amounts are charged per child and are non-refundable.

The following HRS forms are required upon registration:

- HRS 3040- Physical (yellow or gold)
- HRS 680- Immunization (blue)

Nutrition

The center provides a healthy morning breakfast, hot lunch and afternoon snack. Monthly menus are posted in your child's classroom. (Parents of Infants), the center provided Enfamil &Soy formula. When the child turns 6 months old, we can provide cereal, jar food, juice etc. We are a peanut-free facility. For this reason, outside food is NOT ALLOWED in our center.

Bad Weather Closing

In order to keep your children safe during threatening weather conditions, we will adhere to the following guidelines. If Hillsborough County Schools are closed, our center may be be closed. If this announcement is publicly broadcasted during our normal operating hours, we will expect you to pick up your children from the center as quickly and as safely as possible. Always check the website/emails for our pop-ups about the center during this time.

Medication

NO OVER THE COUNTER MEDICINE!!!!

All medication, over the counter inclusive, must be prescribed by a doctor. We may not dispense any medication without a written, dated, and signed permission of the parent. Medication must be in the box with the pharmacy/ doctor information. This regulation may not be waived under any circumstance, since we are bound by the State of Florida Childcare Regulations. The following procedures must be followed exactly before we may dispense any medication.

- All medication is given out at 12:00PM ONLY!!!!!
- The medicine form should be filled out completely and signed by the parents and last one only week.
- Utensils used to measure medication should be kept in a zip lock bag.
- Please give the medicine to the office along with the form.



Notice for Withdrawal

We require at least a two weeks written notice prior to withdraw your child from the center. At which time, your security deposit will be applied to the last week, only if the child has been enrolled for 90 consecutive days. Any amount is left over is non-refundable.

Field Trips

From time to time, field trips will be taken. All permission slips must be signed and returned before your child will be allowed to participate in the trip. Children must be in Kindergarten to be eligible to go on any field trips.

Messages/Communication

- If your child will not be attending school, please contact the school first thing in the morning.
- If your child will be late to school, please contact the school the first chance you get. We will not accept any children between the hours of 9:30am-2:30pm.
- If someone other than the child's parents or legal guardian will be picking up the child, the school must be informed in advance by email(the first and last name of the person you authorize to pick up must match with their ID) and the person or persons picking up the child must show ID.
- Information about daily activities will be provided by Daily Sheets (infants) and Folders (Preschoolers).

Supplies

Infants & Toddlers: parents are required to provide diapers, ointments, and wipes as needed for their child. Pacifier, blankets, and change of clothes are also required and should be left at school. An additional charge of \$10 per week will be applied if you don't bring diapers or wipes for your child.

Preschoolers: a change of clothing should be provided and left at the school. In addition a blanket and a pillow.

Discipline

The only form of discipline implemented at Time of Wonder School is positive reinforcement. Positive reinforcement is to discourage unacceptable behavior and promote positive behavior. Sometimes children bite. If the problem persist, the parents will be called to pick up their child immediately. After that we can ask the parents to withdraw their child from the center.

Referral Policy

We will give one child a week of free tuition to any parent who is responsible for enrollment of another child or children. The only provisions are that the child remains with us for at least three months on a fulltime basis.
